organized a ' Birthday Full Contact Karate Tournament' at the covered Hall of National Sports Council in Kathmandu Nepal to mark the "30th auspicious happy birthday ceremony of Her Royal Highness Crown Princess Himani Rajya Laxmi Devi Shah" for consecutive 2 days on 23 and 24 September 2005. The tournament conducted with the participation of a total number of 75 male and female karatekas was inaugurated by the Minister of Education and Sports Mr. Radha Krishna Mainali amid a function. During the inauguration function, Ministers of Education & Sports Mr. Radha Krishna Mainali, Assistant Minister for Physical Planning and Development Mr. G. Gauchan , Assistant Minister for Education and Sports Mr. Sinet Shrestha, Member Secretary of National Sports Council Mr. Kishor Bahadur Singh had opined their views on the importance of the event.
